Becky cowrote “Freedom,” the lead-off track of The Infamous Stringdusters 2018 Grammy-winning album *Laws of Gravity*, and penned the title cut of Special Consensus’ album *Scratch Gravel Road*, a 2013 Bluegrass Album Of The Year Grammy nominee.

Touring extensively with The Becky Buller Band, she recently released *Crêpe Paper Heart*, her 4<sup>th</sup> solo album, and her second recording on the Dark Shadow Recording label.

Becky is the recipient of 6 IBMA awards, including the 2016 Fiddler and Female Vocalist Of The Year.

Equally passionate about Bluegrass music education, Becky teaches fiddle, singing and songwriting at workshops, camps and in private lessons both at her studio in Manchester, Tenn., and online with students around the world.
